Shoulder to cuff measures 22 1/2 inches, and Collar to hem measures 23 inches. Marie Windsor was known in the film industry as the Queen of the Bs. B movies were produced by smaller studios with lower budgets, but were extremely popular with audiences, and now have a modern following. She had a long and prolific career that started with a job as a telephone operator, then a radio actress which led to her writing gags for comedian, Jack Benny. ahead of her time, she would submit the jokes under her initials for fear that he might be prejudiced against a woman gag writer. Once he found out she was talented, and a striking 5 foot nine beauty, Jack Benny had a producer sign her to a film contract. She became the quintessential femme fatale, for film noir. classics, like force of evil 1948 and the narrow margin 1952. Windsor also starred in Director Stanley Kubrick's heist film the killing 1956. In addition to her radio, film and television work, she served on the board of the screen actors guild for over 25 years.
